Announcement of Recruitment of Assistant Professors,  
Research Institute for Mathematical Sciences (RIMS)

The Research Institute for Mathematical Sciences (RIMS), Kyoto University announces the recruitment of Assistant Professors as per below. Selection will be done through screening of documents and possibly through interviews (applicants are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses in attending face-to-face interviews). Promising researchers regardless of any nationality or gender are encouraged to apply for the position.

Positions: a few vacancies of assistant professors

Expected starting date of appointment: April 1, 2026, or as soon as possible thereafter.

Eligibility:

Each applicant must have earned a Ph.D. degree by the starting date of the appointment, or must demonstrate equivalent ability as a researcher.

It is expected that successful applicants should be actively engaged in teaching during the three-year term of reappointment. Therefore, they must be able to deliver lectures in Japanese during the term of reappointment.

Area of specialization: Mathematics and mathematical sciences.

Salary and fringe benefits: Determined on the basis of Kyoto University Regulations Regarding Salaries of Faculty and Staff.

Term of employment: Seven years. Reappointment may be granted only once.

Term of employment under the reappointment is three years.

However, during the term of office, if they take childcare leave, family care leave or leave to accompany their spouses, the period of absence shall be discounted towards the term of service. Details on the review process for reappointment are given (in Japanese) at the URL below.

Probation period: Six months.

Working hours: 08:30-17:15 Break time: 12:00-13:00

Holidays: Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays, Year-end and New Year holidays, and

Foundation Day (June 18).

Overtime and other explanations: Seven hours and 45 minutes per day, 38 hours 45 minutes per week under a discretionary work system.

If the discretionary work system for specialized work is not applied, work 5 days a week from 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. (break 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.) Overtime may be required.

Social insurance: Eligible for MEXT\* mutual aid association membership, employees' pensions, employment insurance, and workers' compensation insurance.

The following documents should be submitted as a single PDF file via the application form. They should be written in Japanese or English on A4 or US letter format.

1. Curriculum Vitae. (Format (alternative format is acceptable))
2. List of publications. (Format (alternative format is acceptable))
3. Copies of a few major publications (only those available in printed form).
4. Summary of achievements and plans for future research of about 3 pages long in total.
5. The names, affiliations, and email addresses of three referees who are familiar with the applicant's research (please state them on the CV).
6. At least one letter of reference from among the three referees listed above. Each letter of reference should be sent by the referees themselves to the email account <rims.jyokyo-application[at]mail2.adm.kyoto-u.ac.jp> and must be received by the deadline.

(If referees still prefer to send the letter of reference by conventional mail, they should follow the instruction for application documents below.)

Applications must be received by **Friday, December 19, 2025, 5:00 p.m. (JST)**. In response to each Job Application, an acknowledgment is to be emailed within two days. If the applicants do not receive an email of receipt within two days, they are asked to contact the email account <rims.recruitment [at] mail2.adm.kyoto-u.ac.jp> for inquiry.

If the applicant still prefers to send the documents by conventional mail, a suitable method should be used, including EMS, DHL, Fedex, in such a way that she can trace the delivery status herself.
